

EMAIL, MAIL & CARE PACKAGES

SENDING EMAILS TO YOUR CAMPER:

We are offering two email options this year:

Option #1:

This service <u>uses a third party camp email provider</u>. **There is a charge and campers will not be able to send outgoing emails**. Your message can include photos, graphic designs and borders.

NOTE: one email = 1 credit.

- Package Option #1 = 4 credits @ \$5.00
- > Package Option #2 = 9 credits @ \$8.00
- Package Option #3 = 13 credits @ \$11.00

All emails are sent to the A/U Ranches once a day, in the morning, from the provider. Your emails will be received by your camper the following day. **Emails will be printed and delivered to each camper's mailbox.**

To set up an account, click on the icon below. When prompted for the code, please enter: 2015adventure.

There is <u>no fee for this option</u>, which is a basic service. It accepts text messages only, no graphics, photos or attachment. Emails received in the morning (before 7:00am MST) will be delivered to your camper by the end of the day.
